## **MINUTES**

SPEAKER: Dianne Greenhouse introduced our speakers from the MUSD. Superintendent Tom Baumgarten, Karalee Hargrove and Matthew Singleton spoke individually in support of the PROP 13 bond issue on our March ballot. During the question time we spoke of the bullying problem, the lack of civility and other issues that are affecting the quality of MUSD education. Superintendent Baumgarten referred us to their website for offering public support for the bond issue.

OUTREACH: Rich Mettling rose to speak about the February  $17^{th}$  rally in support of Health Care for All. The rally is at 247 and 62 from 10 - 12. Everyone is invited and encouraged to bring friends.

VOTER REGISTRATION: Jo Ann Bollen reported that they have registered 300 Democratic voters, mostly in Victorville. She also reported that voting by mail, using a paper ballot, was the safest way to vote. She reminded us to verify our registration in advance of the primary.
